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Elections Calgary is a division of the City Clerk’s Office responsible for independently and impartially administering the Returning Officer’s accountabilities in General Elections, by-elections and votes of the electors on behalf of The City of Calgary, the Calgary Board of Education and the Calgary Roman Catholic Separate School Division.

Voting will take place as follows:

Advance Vote will take place from **October 6 to 11, 2025 between the hours of 10 a.m. and 7 p.m.** Advance Vote locations are listed on page 5.

Voting opportunities for care facility and shelter residents will take place from **October 6 to 10, 2025.** The hours and days of voting are posted in each location at least 48 hours in advance. A list of participating facilities can be found on page 6.

Election Day voting will take place on **October 20, 2025 between the hours of 10 a.m. and 8 p.m.** Election Day voting locations are listed by ward on pages 8-21.

Voting information

Voter identification (ID)

In order to vote, you must produce for inspection one or more of the acceptable forms of identification (ID) required by Section 53 of the *Local Authorities Election Act*.

Option 1: If your name appears on the permanent electors register you must produce one piece of photo ID issued by a Canadian government. For example, a driver's licence, an Alberta ID card or a Canadian passport.

Option 2: If your name is not on the permanent electors register, or it is but you do not have photo ID issued by a Canadian government, you must complete Form 13 (Elector Register) at the voting station and provide:

- one piece of photo ID issued by a Canadian government that contains your name and address, or
- one piece of ID from any of the documents below that contains your name and address, or
- an eligible voter to vouch for you and one piece of ID from any of the following documents that contains your name.

Voters must complete a statement (Form 13) confirming their eligibility to receive a school board ballot (either Calgary Board of Education or Calgary Roman Catholic Separate School Division).

Government-issued documents

- Alberta driver's licence or ID card.
- Fishing, trapping, or hunting licence.
- Government cheque or cheque stub.
- Income/property tax assessment notice.
- Letter from a public curator, public guardian or public trustee.
- Statement of government benefits (e.g. employment insurance, old-age security, social assistance, disability support or child tax benefits).

School, college or university documents

- Correspondence issued by a school, college or university.

Other documents

- Bank/credit card statement or personal cheque.
- Insurance policy or coverage card.
- Pension Plan statement of benefits, contributions or participation.
- Residential lease or mortgage statement.
- Utility bill (e.g. telephone, public utilities commission, television, hydro (electric), gas or water).
- Vehicle ownership, registration or insurance certificate.
- Any other piece of identification authorized by the Chief Electoral Officer that contains both name and address.

Attestation form

A letter or form (attestation) confirming that the person lives at the stated address is available online at electionscalgary.ca/voterID.

Vouching

If a voter does not have acceptable ID with their current address, they may have another voter vouch for their address. The voter must provide acceptable ID from the list above with their name on it. The person vouching must complete a statement (Form 14) and must be eligible to vote, have acceptable ID, and be listed on the permanent electors register. The person vouching may only do this for one household (maximum) and may not do so if they were vouched for themselves.

Voting information

Why vote?

Every Canadian citizen has the right to vote. It is how Canadians choose which leaders represent them and voting is a responsibility that all Canadians should exercise. Your community is shaped by the outcome of an election — voting is one of the most important ways you can advocate for yourself and your community.

What is the vote for?

City of Calgary mayor

City of Calgary councillors

Calgary Board of Education (or public school) trustees

Calgary Roman Catholic Separate School Division (or separate school) trustees

Candidates

The final list of nominated candidates will be available after 12 p.m. (noon) on Sept. 23, 2025.

Who can vote?

To vote in the General Election, you must, on the day you choose to vote:

- be at least 18 years old,
- be a Canadian citizen,
- reside in Alberta, and
 - in the city of Calgary, to vote for mayor,
 - in the ward, to vote for councillor,
 - in the Calgary Board of Education jurisdiction ward for public school trustee; or
 - in the Calgary Roman Catholic Separate School Division jurisdiction ward for separate school trustee. A **separate school trustee** voter must also declare that they are of the same faith as the Calgary Roman Catholic Separate School Division (Roman Catholic),
- show one piece of the authorized pieces of ID (see page 1).

What to expect when voting

For the 2025 General Election, voters may request up to three ballot types:

- One for election of the office of **mayor**,
- One for the election of their **councillor**, and
- One for the election of their **school board trustee**.

Voter Checklist

- ☐ Check your eligibility to vote.
- ☐ Look up your ward.
- ☐ Get informed – find out who is running for mayor, in your ward for councillor, and who is running for school board trustee (if applicable).
- ☐ Make a vote plan – look up your designated Election Day voting station and Advance Vote opportunities to help you decide when and where to vote.
- ☐ Make sure you have one of the acceptable forms of ID.
- ☐ Get out and VOTE!

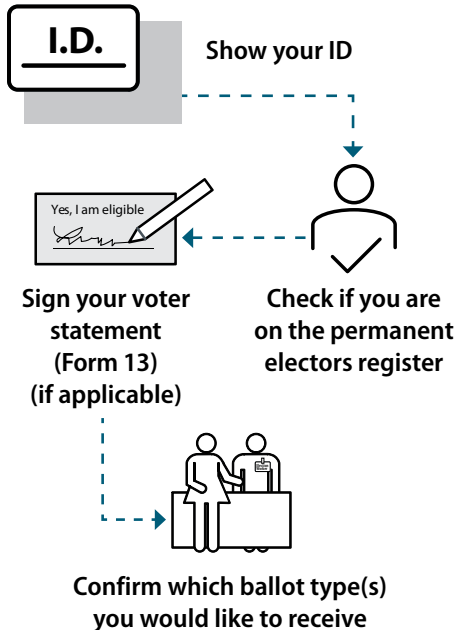
Personal information

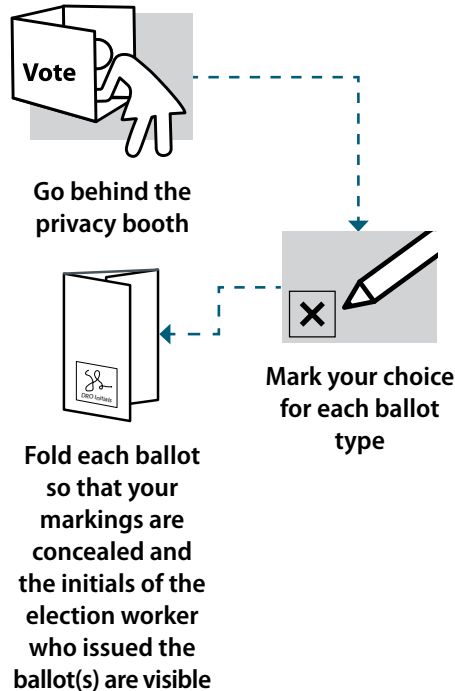

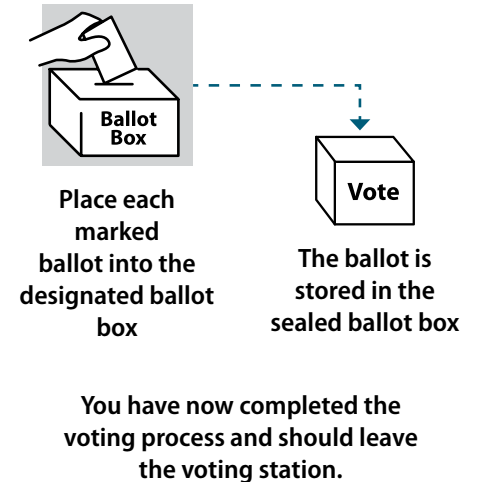

If you're not on the permanent electors register, you can still vote!

Bring one piece of acceptable ID (see page 1) and you will be added at the voting station by completing a statement (Form 13). If you're requesting a school board ballot (either public or separate), you will complete a statement (Form 13) confirming your eligibility.

Counting ballots and results

After 8 p.m. on Election Day, ballots will be hand counted by election officials in voting stations. Ballots cast during the Advance Vote period as well as special (mail-in) ballots will be hand counted by election officials at a counting centre after 7:30 p.m. on Election Day.

Unofficial election results will be made available on electionscalgary.ca, as reported from voting stations and the counting centre on Election Day, and additional days, as required. Once unofficial results are verified, official election results will be made available on electionscalgary.ca after 12 p.m. (noon) on Oct. 24, 2025.

When can I vote?

Advance Vote (October 6–11, 2025)

You can cast your vote at any Advance Vote station. Advance Vote stations will be open 10 a.m. – 7 p.m. in Calgary.

Election Day (October 20, 2025)

On Election Day, you must vote at your designated voting station. Voting stations will be open 10 a.m. – 8 p.m. in Calgary.

Voting information

Special (mail-in) ballots

If you are unable to vote in person during the Advance Vote or on Election Day for any reason, you may apply to vote by mail-in ballot.

Applications for mail-in ballots can be made:

- Online at electionscalgary.ca/mailinballot,
- By phoning 403-476-4100,
- In person at the Elections Calgary Mail-in Ballot office located in Deerfoot Junction III (DJ3) building, Suite 101, 1212 31 Avenue NE, Calgary, or
- In writing to Elections Calgary at
#207A PO Box 2100 Station M Calgary, AB T2P 2M5.

Voters who wish to vote by mail-in ballot must have their name contained on the permanent electors register (electors register). If a voter is not on the electors register, they will be required to sign a statement and provide acceptable identification to complete their request.

Key dates:

- **Sept. 29, 2025:**
Mail-in ballots start to be mailed out.
- **Oct. 3, 2025:**
Last day to request a mail-in ballot package to be sent by mail. Requests made after Oct. 3, 2025 need to be picked up in person from the Elections Calgary Mail-in Ballot office located at Deerfoot Junction III (DJ3) Building, Suite 101, 1212 31 Avenue NE, Calgary.
- **Oct. 20, 2025 at 10 a.m.:**
Deadline to request a package for pickup.
- **Election Day, Oct. 20, 2025 at 12 p.m. (noon):**
Deadline for mail-in ballots to be received and be counted by returning the package:
 - by mail, or
 - in person at the Elections Calgary Mail-in Ballot office:
Deerfoot Junction III (DJ3) Building,
Suite 101, 1212 31 Avenue NE, Calgary

When a voter receives their package, they will need to follow the mail-in ballot instructions included to fill out the ballots and complete their package. A copy of a voter's acceptable ID needs to be included with the completed mail-in ballot package. A copy could be:

- a printed photo of your ID, or
- a photocopy of your ID

If Canada Post services are disrupted, Elections Calgary will use a courier to send mail-in ballot packages, where possible. Return courier will be at the voter's expense.

Accessible voting

What if I need help voting?

Each voting station is inspected to ensure it meets our accessibility standards. Use the Where Do I Vote tool found online at electionscalgary.ca/wheretovote to learn more about accessibility at the voting stations and to help plan your visit.

Several supports are available for voters who require assistance to vote:

- Magnifiers, tactile voting templates, signature guides, braille or large print lists of candidates and large-grip pencils are available at voting stations upon request.
- You can bring someone to a voting station to help you vote. Helpers must be age 18 or older and must complete a form available at the voting station.
- You can ask an election worker to help you mark your ballot. All election workers are required to maintain secrecy of the vote.
- You can do a curbside vote if you are unable to enter a voting station. Election workers will bring the ballot(s) outside to an accessible location. Please bring someone who can enter the voting station to alert an election worker to your request. Our workers are unable to serve voters in their vehicles. Voters must be served on voting station property.
- A "Languages Spoken in the Voting Station" sign is posted on the door of every voting station, and lists the languages spoken by election workers in your station, who can help to translate instructions or ballot(s).
- You can use your phone as an assistive device when reviewing forms or marking ballots.

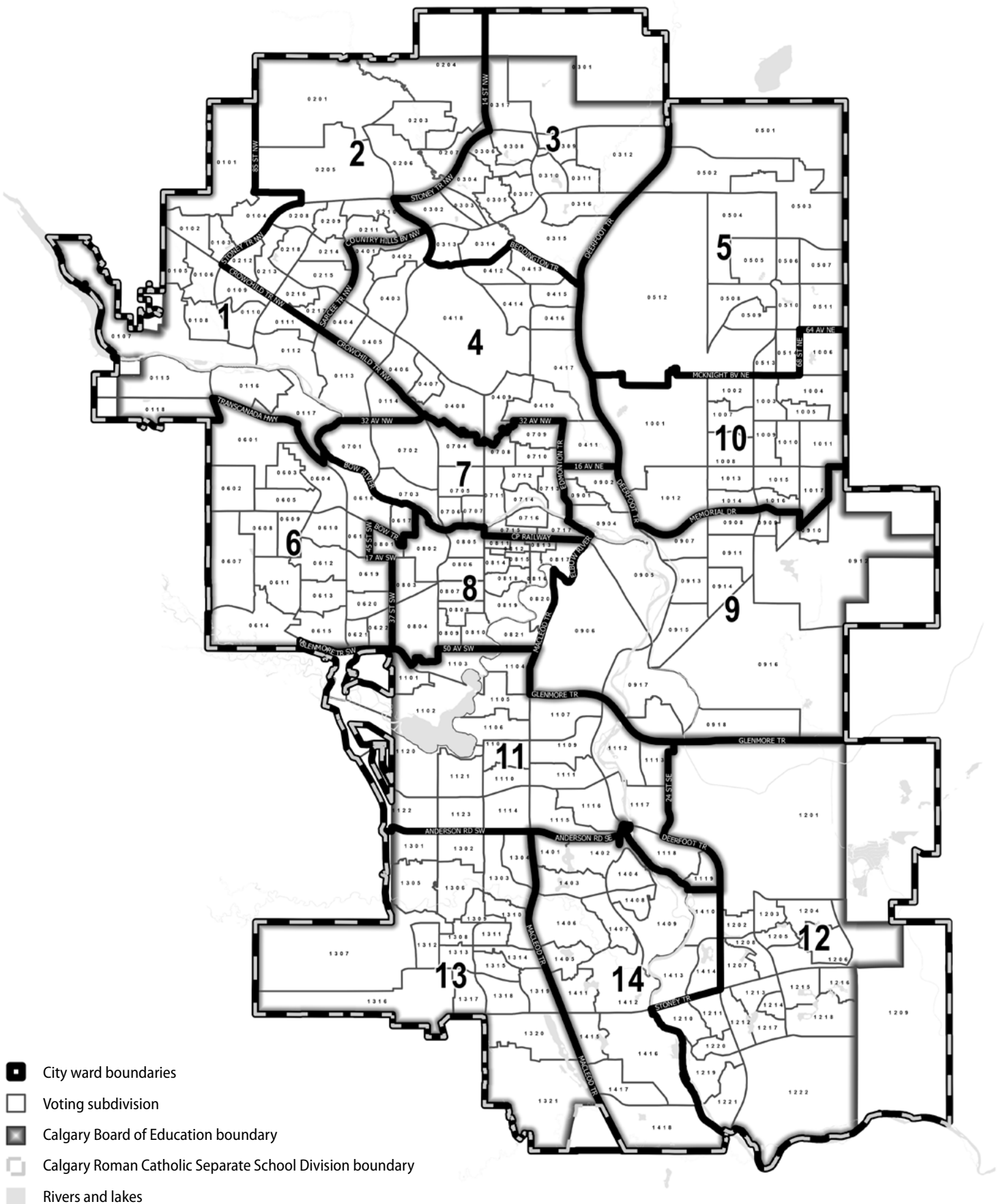

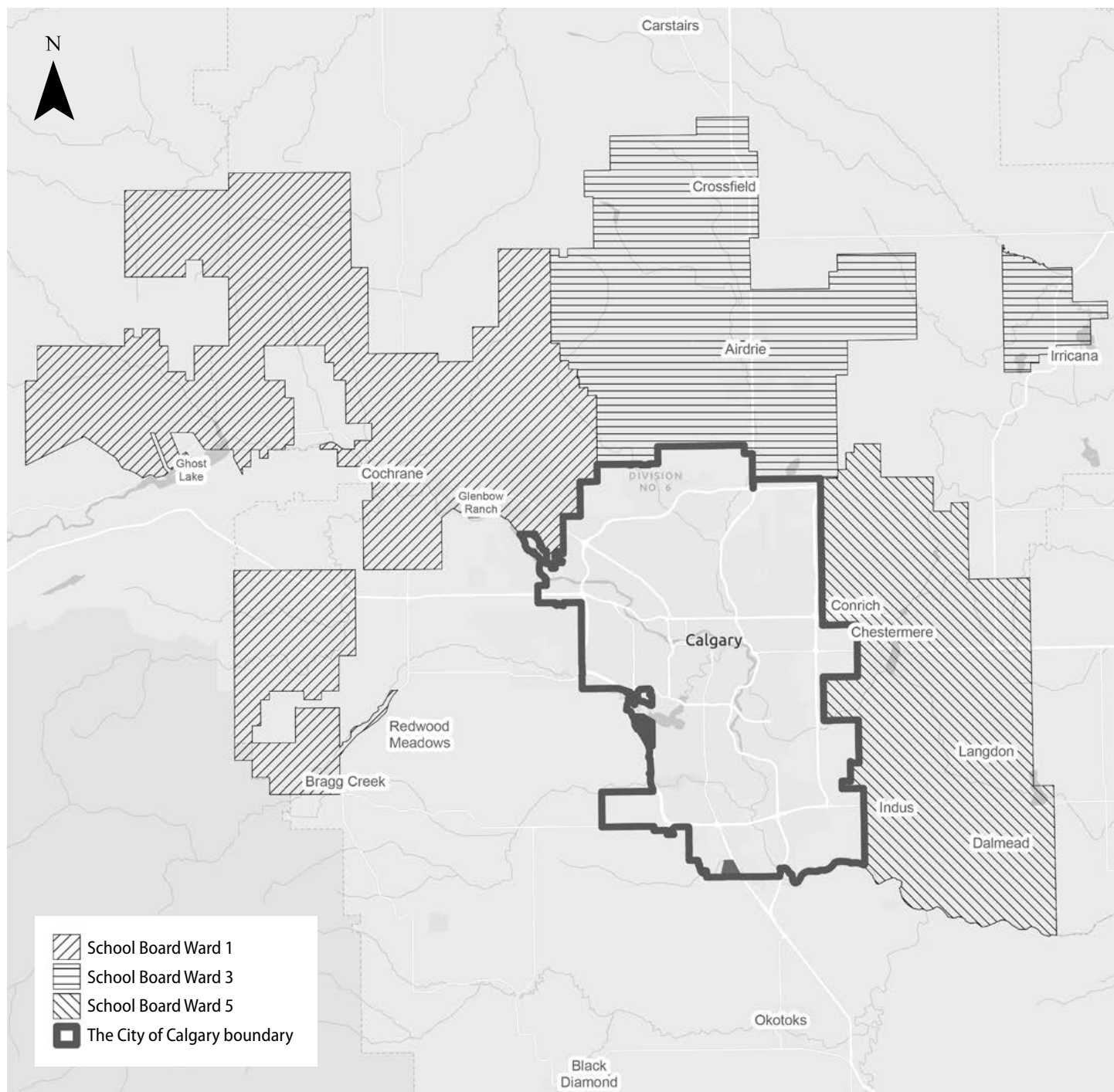
